Statement of Intent

I intend to make three any full looks of my final line up for part two of this course. Below I have mentioned what and how I intend to produce.

- I intend to create breathable looks like tunics or kimonos paired with skirt and paints as Indian Monk's garments and their silhouettes in my story board suggest me. Cape loose sleeve also is an option.
- I intend to combine these key blocks with some detailing, which create a sort of meditative effect with the focus on a bit of drape, layers and movement, something that draws you in. Liberated with a shift from smaller scale to bigger scale. I intend to create three whole looks, most probably it would be a one-piece dress or paired with light weight corded sheer skirt and a wrap(scarf) around the head like an Indian Sari.
- To achieve the meditational effect i want to develop my own textile by using some kind of cording or pin tucks techniques. I
 am considering materials e.g., polyester mix silk, organza silk and cotton mix voile with the focus on its light weight.
- Fabric Dye- I am considering dying cording and some part of my final looks with Turmeric, as its highly valued in natural medicine as well as textiles. In Ayurvedic healing turmeric is believed to help with a number of skin **ailments**, **heart**, **and liver**, **so dying with turmeric is a great way of combining both beauty aesthetics and function**.
 - I am fully committed to produced my this body of work. I will contribute my 100% to create my collection successfully.
 - I position myself in the **artisanal**, **hand crafted and experimented Haute Couture design category**. I intend to create Summer/Spring/Womenswear.
 - This collection I position in the luxury market. I believe **Dover Street** market would be the right space for this collection.
