A curated selection of fifteen "Outstanding Projects" completed over the past 18 months, chosen by Index-Design's editorial team, offers a current snapshot of the industry's creativity. The guide also features five outdoor design projects, underscoring the growing importance of the relationship between indoor spaces and nature in supporting well-being.
