This rebranding marks a new chapter for the firm, led by Principals Pat Blackburn and Elsa Brown, who will build upon Davis' legacy of innovative, sustainable and creative design while bringing in fresh perspectives and a commitment to compelling and collaborative design.

After more than three decades at the helm, Davis steps into a new phase of his professional journey.
