








Behind a closed gate and past a long courtyard, this hidden family house with a garden offers an oasis of peace in Paris's 11th arrondissement.






Defined by stainless steel surfaces and Gaggenau appliances, the kitchen reflects the simple material palette of oak, plaster, stone, and steel.








The bathroom is made of Vaselli stone, emphasizing natural texture and craftsmanship.













No decorative elements, no art — nothing to disturb the calmness of the interior. Plastered walls and soft daylight create an atmosphere of clarity and calm.








The ceilling was opened for the oak staircase that brings natural light into all levels and forms the spine of the house.








The bedroom uses a light fixture from ONE A. Built-in storage offers a clean, minimalist look.




