









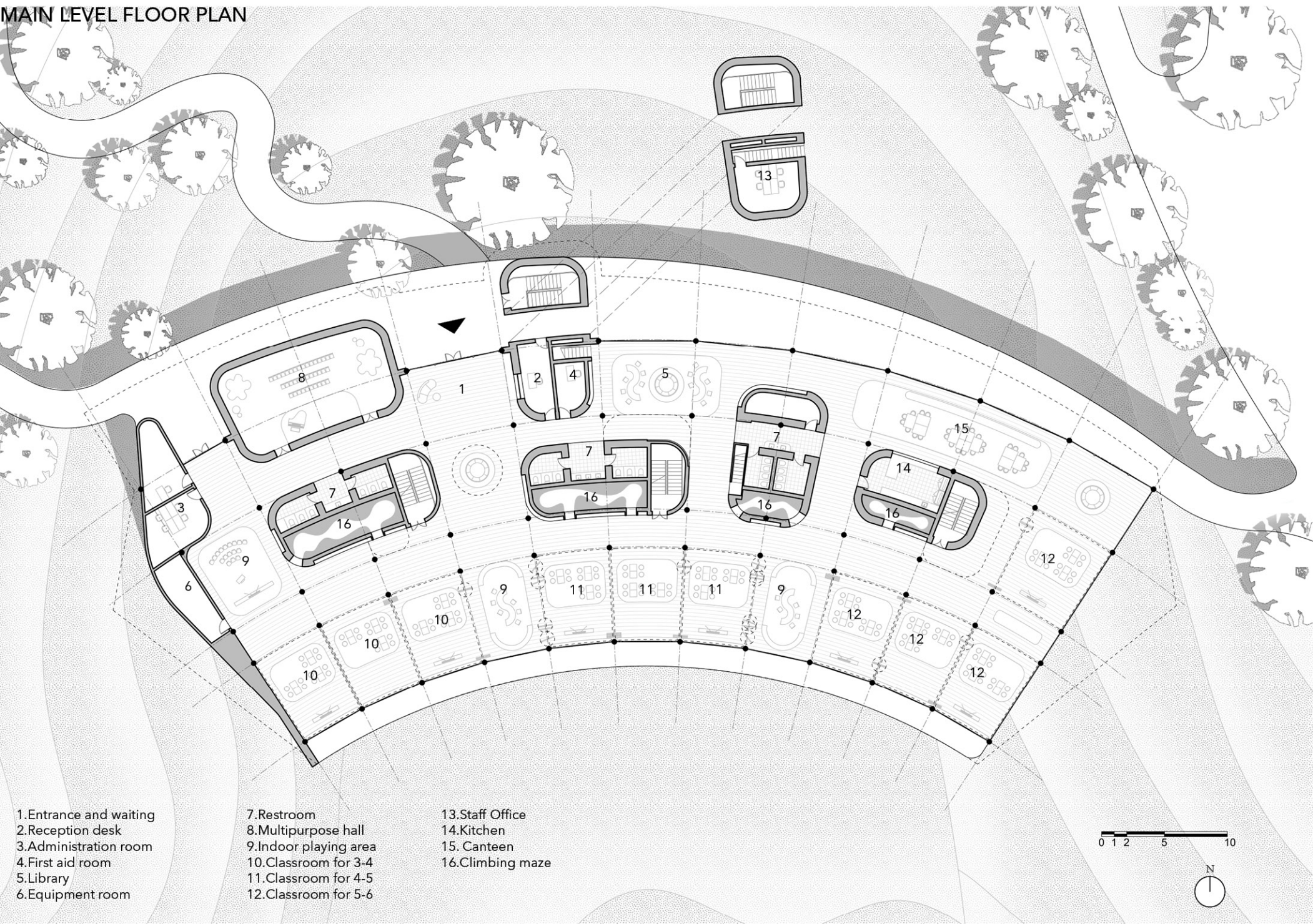




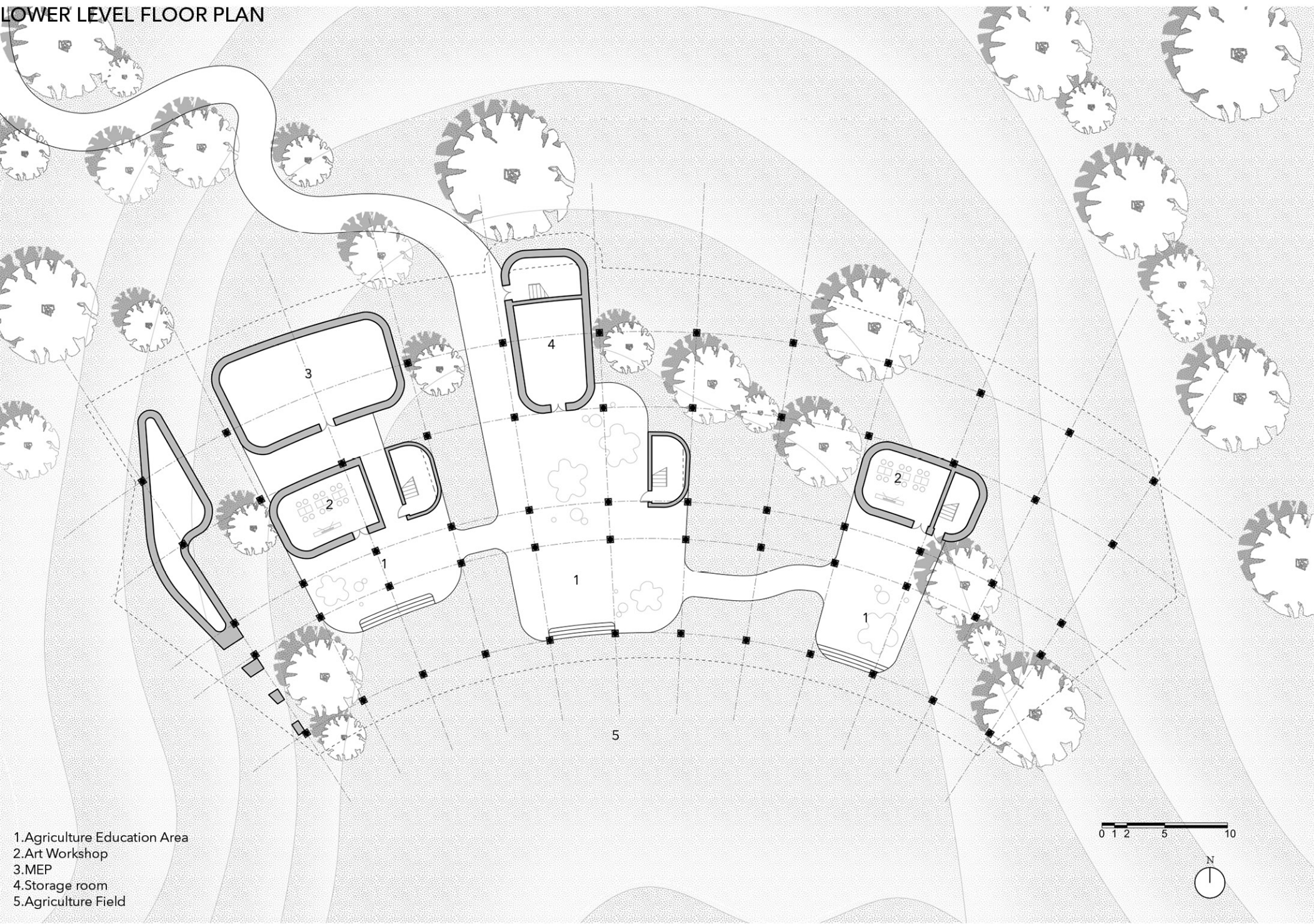




MAIN LEVEL FLOOR PLAN

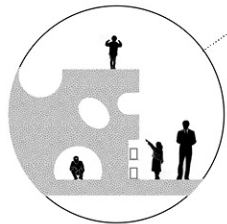
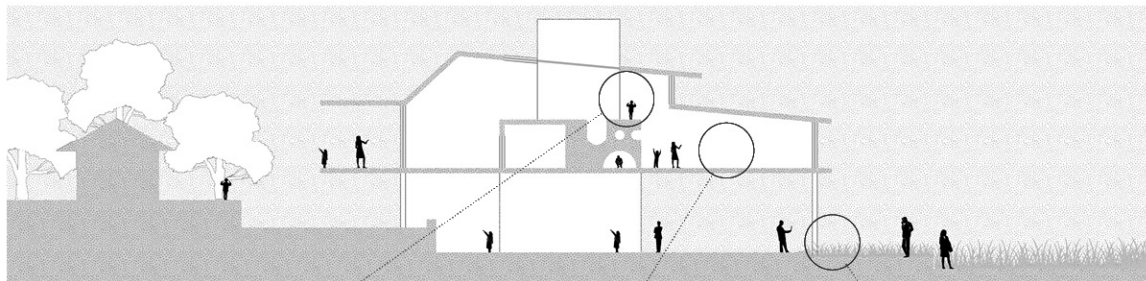


LOWER LEVEL FLOOR PLAN



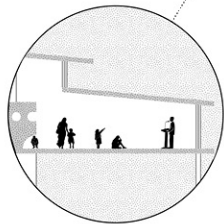
- 1. Agriculture Education Area

- 5. Agriculture Field





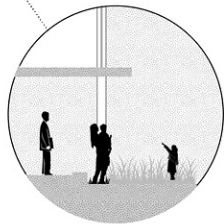
Private

It invites children to crawl through a series of capsule-like rooms arranged like a maze. Each capsule offers a different experience—some are cozy reading nooks, some are quiet sleeping areas, and others are playful zones filled with toys and ball pits.



Activity

The activity spaces are organized into interior and exterior zones. The interior features with movable panels that divide classrooms and reconfigured into a larger space. The exterior includes sports facilities designed for both educational and community use.
