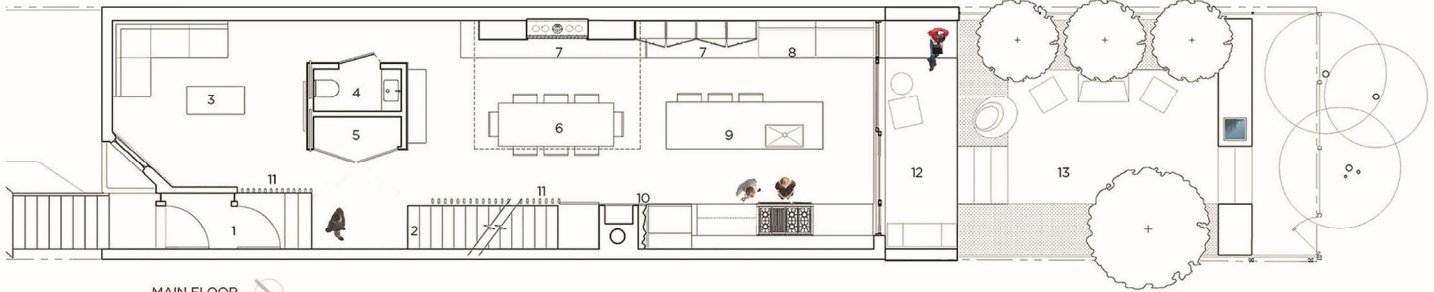


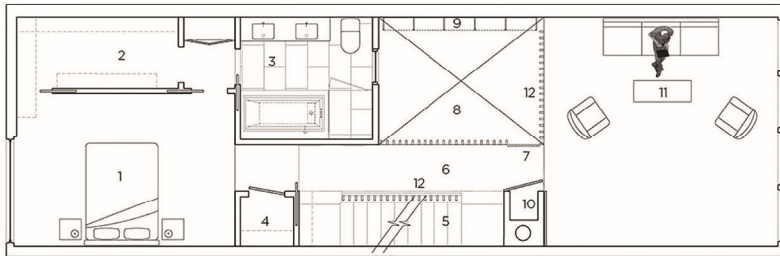

## MAIN FLOOR

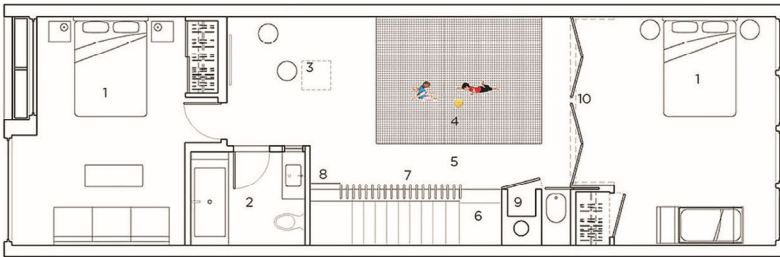
1. Entry vestibule

12. Douglas fir wood slats

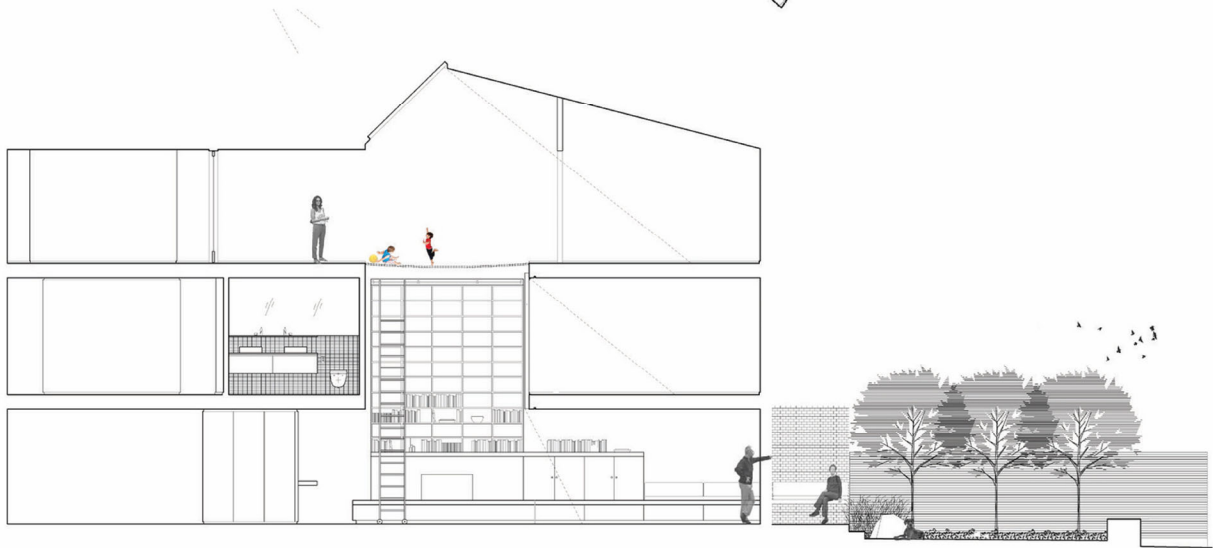
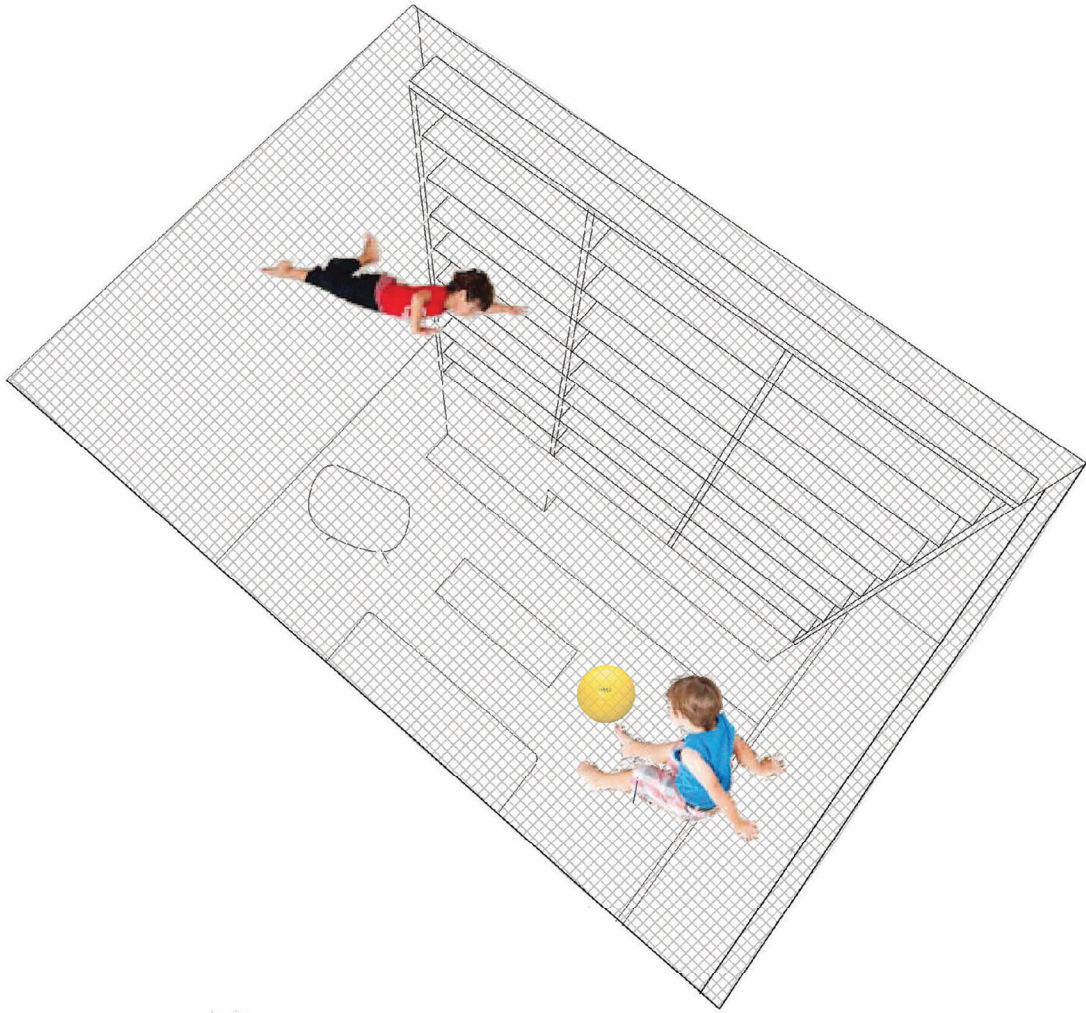
