- More than 1000 jobs created on-site through construction.
 Approx 400 direct permanent roles created by this development.
- Over £6.5m in transport contributions (new bus route, riverboat enhancements)
- Over 50% of the development is designated amenity space.
- Over 600m of Thames waterfront path opened.
- Significant in terms of social welfare, economic benefits, and environmental sustainability
